

Proof of Primary Residence



Two supporting documents are required to prove your primary address. The documents must be dated within 90 days of the date of being submitted.

Vehicle registration card	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid registration
Driver's Licence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid licence
Bank Statement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most recent period
Mortgage document	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current mortgage document
Residential lease	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current lease document
Personal income tax document	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recent filing
Employment confirmation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay statement • Letter from your employer on their letterhead and signed by an official of the company.
Social Assistance benefit confirmation	<p>Some examples of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Child Tax Benefit • Employment Insurance (EI) benefits • Employment and Income Assistance (EIA) • Statement of Old Age Security benefits • Statement of Canada Pension Plan Benefits

Guests from outside the country must provide one document showing a planned return date.
