 Have you done any sandbagging? Has your Emergency Operations Centre been opened? How many municipal employees are working to respond to this event? Have you evacuated any residents? If so, where are they presently located? Have you evacuated any livestock?

3. RESPONSE ACTIONS PLANNED

- What actions, such as those outlined in Question #2, are you planning to do in the near future? Please provide an outline of your plans for the next 48 hours, and for the next 7 days.
- What are your priority concerns for the next 48 hours and 7 days? If there is a particular operational problem that you are concerned with, please indicate your concern in this section.

4. DAMAGES

 What kinds of damages have been reported? Can you break them into private, business, or municipal damages? Damages may include basement flooding or road damage.
